

amending its charter or articles of incorporation, or thereafter adopting or excuting a certificate of increase or decrease of capital stock, shall within sixty days after such amendment, adoption or execution file a duly authenticated copy thereof, in the same places and manner as the authenticated copy of the charter or articles were originally filed to qualify the corporation to engage in business in the Territory. No contract made by such a corporation with residents of the Territory shall be enforced at the instance of the corporation in the Courts of the Territory after sixty days and until such filing shall have been made, however such contract may be enforced by the contracting resident."

Corporation taxes, fees and licenses.—annual tax not required of certain corporations.

Section 2. Section 1016, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, is hereby amended by adding an additional paragraph at the end of said section to read as follows:

"Corporations organized under Article V, Educational, Religious, Social, Fraternal, Charitable and Scientific Corporations and under Article VI, Corporation Sole, shall not be required to pay such annual corporation tax."

CHAPTER 43.

AN ACT

[S. B. 8]

Requiring domestic corporations to designate agents to accept service of process, providing for time for filing and the fees therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the provisions of Sections 942, 943, and 944, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, as amended

by Chapter 89, Session Laws of Alaska, 1935, shall be and are hereby extended to apply to every domestic business corporation, that is every corporation organized under the provisions of Chapter 8, Session Laws of Alaska, 1931, codified in Sections 901 to 936, inclusive, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, or any laws amendatory thereof.

Section 2. The time for domestic business corporations to file the certificates of designation of agents shall be as follows:

Domestic Business Corporations: certificates of designation of agents, time for filing—fee.

(a): As to domestic business corporations already existing on or before January 1, 1942.

(b): As to domestic business corporations hereafter organized within sixty days from the date of incorporation which for purposes of this Act shall be the date the articles of incorporation are filed with the Auditor of Alaska.

Section 3. A fee of \$5 shall be charged by the Auditor and paid to him for the filing of any appointment or designation of agent, or for a revocation thereof.

CHAPTER 44.

AN ACT

[S. B. 31]

To amend Section 2161, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933; fixing the time for the payment of temporary disability compensation and defining "wage earning capacity" of an employee suffering from temporary disability.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Section 2161, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be, and the same is hereby amended by adding to
