

CHAPTER 49.

AN ACT

[S. B. 55]

Making applicable to illegitimate children and their putative fathers the provisions of sections 5088 to 5092 inclusive, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Sections 5088 to 5092 inclusive, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be and the same are hereby amended so that the provisions thereof shall apply to any illegitimate child and to the putative fathers thereof.

Family desertion and non-support; act applied to illegitimate children and their putative fathers.

Section 2. Complaint against the putative father of any deserted or abandoned illegitimate child shall be made as provided in Sec. 5089 Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, and may be verified by the person described in said section except the mother of such child.

CHAPTER 50.

AN ACT

[H. B. 89]

To provide for the sale and disposition of obsolete and surplus property.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That any obsolete or surplus property of the Territory for which there is no immediate or prospective use and any property remaining in the hands of or under the control of any commission or board created

Board of Administration; to take possession of and sell, lease, etc., obsolete Territorial property.
