

by the Territory after such commission or board for any cause ceases to function shall be taken possession of by the Board of Administration, who are hereby authorized to sell, lease, license or otherwise dispose of the same upon such terms as shall by them be deemed for the best interests of the Territory.

## CHAPTER 51.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 91]

To compensate J. A. Korba of Fairbanks, Alaska, and Herbert Simpson of Fairbanks, Alaska, for injuries received by them while in the employ of the University of Alaska, making an appropriation and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of Three Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-five (\$3,375.00) Dollars out of funds of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying the following claims:

To compensate J. A. Korba of Fairbanks, Alaska, for expenses arising from an injury received by the said J. A. Korba while in the employ of the University of Alaska .....	\$1,215.00
To compensate Herbert Simpson of Fairbanks, Alaska, for the loss of his right eye incurred through an injury while employed by the University of Alaska .....	2,160.00

Appropriations

The sum hereby appropriated shall be paid upon vouchers approved by the President of the University of Alaska, which said vouchers shall show the employment, the dates and character of the injuries.

An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 52.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 36]

To amend Section 1189, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, as amended by Chapter 38, Session Laws of Alaska, 1939, relating to the issuance of marriage licenses.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 1189, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, as amended by Chapter 38, Session Laws of Alaska, 1939, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1189. Application and facts required before license issues. No person shall be joined in marriage until a license shall have been obtained for that purpose from a United States Commissioner. No marriage license shall be issued unless the contracting parties shall three days prior to the time of the said marriage file
