

## CHAPTER 63.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 21]

To assist the town of Craig in enlarging the school house and making an appropriation.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The sum of \$10,000.00 is hereby appropriated out of the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated to assist the town of Craig in enlarging their school house.

Section 2. This sum will become available after the town of Craig has appropriated the same amount.

Section 3. The construction or enlargement of the school shall be under the supervision of the Board of Education.

## CHAPTER 64.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 77]

Relating to veterinarians, amending Chapter 73 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1931, and making an appropriation; and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 73 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1931 (Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, Section 622) is hereby amended to read as follows:

Veterinarians.  
Governor to  
employ one or  
more.

“Section 1. The Governor of Alaska is hereby authorized either independently or in cooperation with the United States Bureau of Biological Survey or any college or any university or like institution to employ one or more veterinarians at such salaries and for such periods as he may find to the best advantage for the purpose of aid and service to the fur raising industry, and for the purpose of aid and service to those engaged in raising livestock and other domestic animals.”

Section 2. Section 2 of Chapter 73 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1931 (Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, Section 623) is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection, to be known as subsection (f), to read as follows:

Duties of  
veterinarian.

“(f) To study problems incidental to the raising of livestock and other domestic animals, to advise those engaged therein upon matters pertaining to the breeding, care and the prevention and cure of diseases thereof.”

Appropriation.

Section 3. There is hereby appropriated out of the funds in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated for the fiscal biennium beginning April 1, 1941, and ending March 31, 1943, the sum of \$10,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act.

Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this law shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
