

CHAPTER 66.

AN ACT

[S. B. 78]

To reimburse the St. Ann's Hospital for services rendered certain indigents, making an appropriation, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$645.00 is hereby appropriated out of the moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated to reimburse the St. Ann's Hospital, Juneau, Alaska, for hospitalization and services and materials in connection therewith furnished certain indigents as follows:

Charles Green or Charlie Gren	\$365.00
Leno Martini	280.00

Payments under this appropriation may be made upon a voucher approved by the Director of Public Welfare.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 67.

AN ACT

[H. B. 87]

Appropriating the sum of Sixty Thousand (\$60,000.00) Dollars for the purpose of constructing and equipping certain buildings in connection with the University of Alaska.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of Sixty Thousand (\$60,000.00) Dollars, out of any moneys

in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of constructing and improving buildings, providing furniture and fixtures for the same, installing additional machinery and equipment in the present power plant, developing an adequate water supply, all on the campus of the University of Alaska, and constructing and improving buildings and clearing land at the agricultural experiment stations of the said University at Fairbanks, Matanuska and Petersburg.

Section 2. The moneys hereby appropriated shall be disbursed in the same manner as other disbursements are made on behalf of the University of Alaska.

CHAPTER 68.

AN ACT

[H. B. 93]

To amend Section 1, Chapter 41 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1939.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Chapter 41, Session Laws of Alaska, 1939, is amended to read as follows:

“Section 1. Bounty on Wolves or Coyotes. There is hereby placed upon every wild lobo or timber wolf and every wild coyote or prairie wolf, legally taken within the Territory bounties of Twenty Dollars on wolves and Seventeen Dollars and Fifty Cents on coyotes, said sums to be paid in accordance with the provisions hereof.”
