

## CHAPTER 69.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 101]

To amend Sub-section (K) of Section 13, Chapter 78, Session Laws of Alaska, 1937.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Sub-section (K) of Section 13, Chapter 78, Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Intoxicating  
Liquor; Boat  
Licenses fee  
raised.

“(K) Boat Licenses: A Boat License shall give to the holder thereof the right to sell intoxicating liquors on boats of two hundred fifty tons or over, United States Custom House measurement, for consumption on the boat; provided, however, that no sale of intoxicating liquor shall be made while such licensed boat is in any Alaskan port. A Boat License fee is Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).”

## CHAPTER 70.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 11]

Making an appropriation to pay for labor, services and supplies expended on the Territorially owned building in Juneau, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Alaska Theatre Company, Inc. did have certain equipment installed in, repairs made to and labor performed on the Territorially owned building in

Juneau without paying for all thereof, and subsequently became insolvent, and the improvements made did add to the value of the building and have since been used by the Territory in its subsequent use of the building, and the same repairs and installations would have been required to have been made by the Territory.

NOW, THEREFORE,

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$2093.30 out of the funds in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to compensate the following for labor, materials, equipment and architectural services in the following respective amounts:

Payment thereof shall be made on vouchers signed by the respective payees.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall become effective upon its passage and approval.
