

CHAPTER 71.

AN ACT

[H. B. 95]

To appropriate funds for the expenses of the Territory of Alaska for the biennium beginning April 1, 1941 and ending March 31, 1943, and for the school years commencing July 1, 1941, and ending June 30, 1942, and commencing July 1, 1942, and ending June 30, 1943, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Four Million Four Hundred Ninety-six Thousand, Nine Hundred Thirty-two Dollars (\$4,496,932.00), or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the expenses of the Territory of Alaska for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1941, and ending March 31, 1942, and for the fiscal year commencing April 1, 1942, and ending March 31, 1943, said sum to be apportioned according to the following schedules:
