

CHAPTER 72.

AN ACT

[H. B. 69]

To amend Section 669, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, pertaining to employment of Assistant or Associate Counsel to the Attorney General of the Territory.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Section 669, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 669. The Attorney General shall have the power, whenever in his judgment the interests of the Territory demand it, to select and appoint counsel who shall be a resident of the Territory and admitted to practice law therein, to act and serve as assistant or associate counsel as the case may be and while so acting and serving shall be known and recognized as Assistant Attorney General with such powers, duties, and privileges as may descend to him as such together with any such as may be specially delegated to him by the Attorney General. When appointment be made of Assistant Attorney General on a salary basis, salary shall not exceed to any one person per annum the sum of Four Thousand Dollars. Expense of employment of assistant or associate counsel by the Attorney General shall be paid out of the appropriation for his office, provided however, that in all actions wherein moneys are recovered to the benefit of the Territory to be covered into the Treasury. With the permission of the Attorney General, the services of the

Assistant Attorney General for the purpose of investigation and/or enforcement in the matter of violation of Territorial Statutes shall be available to the heads of the departments of the Territorial Government, including the Territorial Liquor Enforcement Officer, but this provision shall not limit the Attorney General in his powers to initiate investigations and enforcements of violations which may come to his attention."

CHAPTER 73.

AN ACT

[H. B. 86]

To authorize the construction of a fireproof vault on the Territorial Building, providing an appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars is hereby appropriated for the construction of a fireproof vault as an addition to the present Territorial Building and for making minor repairs and changes to the present building.

Section 2. The Superintendent of Public Works shall supervise the work of construction and repairs.

Section 3. An emergency is declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
