

machines, instruments or devices which shall not be removed except by the Treasurer or his duly authorized representative in the presence of the owner, operator or lessee: Provided, that the provisions of this Act shall not apply to any machine used exclusively for the purpose of vending merchandise,

Tax stamps.

(b) No license shall be issued, but upon payment of the tax, a receipt in the form of a stamp shall be issued. Such stamps shall be serially numbered and shall be of a distinctive color for the year of issue. The serial number and year shall appear thereon in conspicuous type and the stamp shall be firmly and conspicuously affixed to the machine upon which such tax has been paid.

Penalty.

A violation of the provisions of this Act shall be subject to the penalties provided by Section 3145 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933.

CHAPTER 77.

AN ACT

[H. B. 116]

To compensate and reimburse Mrs. Bessie Arketa for services rendered and expenses incurred in caring for William Gardner, an indigent infant, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation
to reimburse for
caring for
indigents,
infant.

Section 1. That the sum of \$144.20 be and the same is hereby appropriated to compensate Mrs. Bessie Arketa for services rendered and expenses incurred in caring for William Gardner, an indigent infant, from November 1, 1938, to and including April 24, 1939.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
