

CHAPTER 9.

AN ACT

[S. B. 7]

To amend Section 589, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, as amended by Chapter 28, Session Laws of Alaska, 1939, relating to the bounty on hair seal and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Section 589 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, as amended by Chapter 28, Session Laws of Alaska, 1939, is hereby amended to read as follows: Amended.

“Section 589. Bounty on Hair Seal. There is hereby placed on every hair seal inhabiting the inland waters and all waters adjacent to the southern coast of Alaska and east of the 152nd Meridian, and the waters of Bering Sea, and lying within a line drawn from the tip of Cape Darby to Port Safety, inclusive, a bounty of Three Dollars (\$3.00), such sum to be paid in accordance with the provisions following.” Hair Seal
bounty.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval. Emergency.

CHAPTER 10.

AN ACT

[H. B. 26]

To amend Section 3 of Chapter 66, Session Laws of Alaska, 1935, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Chapter 66, Session Laws Amended.

of Alaska, 1935, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Kodiak Hospital,

Section 3. That the said hospital be operated and conducted by the Territorial Board of Health and that its management be in the hands of a local Board of Trustees consisting of three persons, appointed by the Common Council of Kodiak, Alaska, and residing at Kodiak, Alaska, and to be governed by rules and regulations prescribed by the said Territorial Board of Health.

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately on its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 11.

AN ACT

[S. Sub. for H. B. 3]

To amend Sections 3, 5 and 9 of Chapter 32, Session Laws of Alaska for 1941, relating to the practice of law in the Territory of Alaska, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Amended.

Section 1. That Section 3 of Chapter 32, Session Laws of Alaska, 1941, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Bar examination,
when, where.

“Section 3. The Board of Law Examiners shall hold examinations at Juneau, Alaska, on the third Monday of October of each year, and at such other times and places in the Territory as may be fixed by said Board.”
