CHAPTER 12.

AN ACT

[H. B. 25]

To supply a deficiency in the appropriation for livestock inspection for the biennium ending March 31, 1943 and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That to meet a deficiency in the appropriation for livestock inspection under the provisions of Section 625, et seq. C.L.A. 1933, for the biennium ending March 31, 1943, the sum of \$2,218.67 is hereby appropriated to compensate the following named persons in the sums stated for the loss of cattle owned by them, which were slaughtered in carrying out the provisions of the Act aforesaid.
