CHAPTER 19.

AN ACT

[S. B. 22]

To amend Sub-division (A) of Section 2 of Chapter 3 of the Extraordinary Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Sub-division (A) of Section 2 of Chapter 3 of the Extraordinary Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as *Amended.* follows:

“A. Welfare Director. The Board of Public Welfare shall appoint a Welfare Director who shall be the chief executive of the Board, whose compensation shall be Four Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$4,800.00) per annum payable monthly in equal installments. The Director shall be appointed for a term of four years and may be removed at the pleasure of the Board. No person shall be appointed Welfare Director unless he be a citizen of the United States, a resident of this Territory and has been such resident at least five years immediately preceding his appointment. The Director may, with the approval of the Board, appoint such assistants and employees as may be necessary for the efficient performance *Welfare Director —Salary, qualifications, etc.*”

of the duties prescribed in this Act and shall fix the compensation of such assistants and employees. The Director shall be subject to the supervision and direction of the Board and shall perform such duties as the Board may assign to him."

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect April 1, 1943.
