

LAWS OF ALASKA

CHAPTER 1.

AN ACT

[H. B. 2]

To appropriate the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars deficiency appropriation, to be used in paying United States Commissioners for recording Vital Statistics records, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars, not otherwise appropriated, or so much as may be necessary be appropriated for the use of the Registrar of Vital Statistics to pay United States Commissioners for recording birth and death certificates. Vital Statistics deficiency appropriation.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval. Emergency.

Approved February 5, 1943.

CHAPTER 2.

AN ACT

[H. B. 8]

To repeal Chapter 41 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1935, forbidding outside employment by employees of the Territory of Alaska earning \$200.00 or more, and Chapter 51 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1935, prohibiting the employment of married persons

whose spouses were earning more than \$200.00 per month; and, declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Employment
Laws repealed.

Section 1. That Chapters 41 and 51 of the Session Laws of Alaska 1935, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

Approved February 17, 1943.

CHAPTER 3.

AN ACT

[H. B. 13]

To pay the Fireman's Fund Insurance Company \$354.92, excess payment made on their premium tax for the year 1941, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation
for Fireman's
Fund Ins. Co.

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$354.92 to pay the Fireman's Fund Insurance Company for an excess payment of the said sum made on their premium tax for the year 1941.

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
