Saving clause.

Section 9. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

Title of Act.

Section 10. SHORT TITLE. This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Model Airport Zoning Act".

Repeal.

Section 11. REPEAL. All Acts or parts of Acts which are inconsistent with the provision of this Act are hereby repealed.

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## CHAPTER 24.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 45]

To amend Section 964, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, as amended by Section 7 of Chapter 89, Alaska Session Laws, 1935, being an Act entitled "An Act to amend Sections 902, 923, 941, 943, 944, 945, 946, 1017, 1020 and 1021, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to business corporations", and to Authorize the Auditor of Alaska to Grant Extensions of Time to Corporations within Which to File Their Annual Reports, and Declaring an Emergency."

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Amended.

Section 1. Section 7, Chapter 89, Alaska Session Laws,

1935, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection (a), namely:

“Subsection 7 (a): The Auditor of Alaska, upon the payment to him of a fee of Five (\$5) Dollars and upon the filing with him of the written, sworn application of any foreign corporation that it, because of inability to audit its books in time or to hold the necessary meeting or due to the necessary absence of one or more of its officers or other similar reasonable cause, cannot file its annual report within the time as hereinbefore limited, may grant such corporation such further extension of time as may be reasonably required by it to file such report not exceeding sixty days not only in his office but also in the office of the Clerk of the District Court of each division wherein the corporation carries on business.”

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 25.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 48]

To appropriate \$325.04 to pay claim of Trick and Murray for 1 Art Metal Safe supplied for the use of the United States Commissioner at Bethel, Alaska.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the funds of the Territorial Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$325.04 to pay Trick and Murray, Seattle, Washington, for 1 Art Metal B Label Safe No. 170-19, supplied to the United States Commissioner at Bethel, Alaska.
