

CHAPTER 26.

AN ACT

[H. B. 55]

To pay the Fairbanks Lumber Supply for lumber and building material furnished the Alaska National Guard, Fairbanks Branch, Fairbanks, Alaska, and making an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation
for lumber for
Alaska National
Guard.

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated, out of money in the treasury of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise obligated, the sum of \$427.15 to pay for the purchase of lumber and building material to the Fairbanks Lumber Supply, Fairbanks, Alaska, by the Alaska National Guard, Fairbanks Branch, Fairbanks, Alaska, during the year 1940.

CHAPTER 27.

AN ACT

[H. B. 56]

To appropriate \$798.49 to pay claim of Trick and Murray for supplies furnished Company "B" of the Alaska National Guard, at Ketchikan.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation
for lockers for
Alaska National
Guard.

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the Territorial Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$798.49, to pay Trick and Murray of Seattle, Washington, for sixty-six steel lockers furnished Company "B" of the Alaska National Guard at Ketchikan, Alaska.
