

## CHAPTER 28.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 321]

To amend Section 1 of Chapter 86, Session Laws of Alaska, 1939, relating to the calling for bids for purchases, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the first paragraph of Section 1 of Chapter 86, Session Laws of Alaska, 1939, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: Repeal.

“Section 1. Every public office, institution, officer or employee of the Territory of Alaska shall obtain sealed competitive bids in writing for all purchases of any kind made in behalf of the Territory of Alaska, where the cost shall be in excess of Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00), and shall award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder subject, however, to the following conditions.”

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval. Emergency.
