## CHAPTER 31.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 44]

To Provide the Procedure for the Substitution of Surety or Sureties on Undertakings, Stipulations and Bonds, and for the Discharge of the former Surety or Sureties Thereon.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The surety or sureties on any undertaking, bond or stipulation, executed or given in any judicial proceeding or filed in any court in Alaska or made or given on behalf of or by any territorial or municipal officer, employee or agent in connection with the duties or performance of the duties of his office may and shall be released and discharged from all liability on such undertaking, bond or stipulation and new surety or sureties substituted in his, its or their stead, upon either the principal, surety or obligee, or, if more than one, then the principals, sureties or obligees filing in such court or presenting to whomever by law is empowered to approve or accept on behalf of the obligee or obligees therein such undertaking, stipulation or bond, his, its or their written application for discharge from such undertaking, stipulation or bond, together with a new undertaking, stipulation or bond, executed by competent surety or sureties, qualified to act as such under the laws of and in the territory, and conditioned not only as in such former undertaking, stipulation or bond but also further that the surety or sureties thereon do and shall accept all liability theretofore or thereafter accruing under both

said former as well as said new undertaking, stipulation or bond and stand in the place of and become substitute or substitutes for the surety or sureties on said former undertaking, stipulation or bond.

Sureties discharged, when.

Section 2. Upon the filing or presenting of such new undertaking, stipulation or bond, and the approval thereof as to form, penalty and surety, the former undertaking, stipulation or bond, as well as the surety or sureties thereon, shall be immediately discharged from all liability in any manner or at any time arising or accruing.

## CHAPTER 32.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 42]

To prohibit the exportation from Alaska of merchandise rationed anywhere in the United States and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Exporting rationed goods, misdemeanor.

Section 1. The exportation from the Territory of any food or any article or commodity which is or may be rationed in the United States, except such as is produced, manufactured, canned or preserved within the Territory, shall be unlawful; and any person who sells, barter, delivers, purchases, receives or possesses any such goods with intent to transport or cause the transportation thereof out of the Territory, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1000 or by imprisonment for not more than one year, or both.
