

CHAPTER 34.

AN ACT

[C. S. H. B. 71]

To require operators of vehicles upon the highways of Alaska to keep to the right in passing other vehicles traveling in the opposite direction and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Vehicles required to keep to right of highway.

Section 1. Whenever any persons operating any vehicles shall meet upon any public highway in the Territory, the persons so meeting shall reasonably turn their vehicles to the right of the center of the road, so as to permit each vehicle to pass without interfering with or interrupting the other.

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 35.

AN ACT

[S. B. 36]

To amend Section 4614, Chapter CLVI, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to revocation of Wills.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Amended.

Section 1. That Section 4614 of Chapter CLVI, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be amended to read as follows:

Will revoked by marriage or divorce, when.

“Section 4614. SUBSEQUENT MARRIAGE; OR DIVORCE REVOKES WILL. A will made by an unmarried person shall be deemed revoked by his or her subsequent marriage. A divorce subsequent to the making of a will shall revoke the will as to the divorced spouse.”
