

CHAPTER 36.

AN ACT

[H. B. 59]

To reimburse the Seward General Hospital and the St. Ann's Hospital, Juneau, for services rendered certain indigents, and making an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Two Hundred Forty Four Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$244.80) is hereby appropriated out of the moneys in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to reimburse the Seward General Hospital, for hospitalizations and services rendered to the following indigents:

CHAPTER 37.

AN ACT

[S. B. 37]
