

CHAPTER 40.

AN ACT

[H. B. 46]

To appropriate funds for the expenses of the Territory of Alaska for the biennium beginning April 1, 1943 and ending March 31, 1945, and for the school years commencing July 1, 1943, and ending June 30, 1944, and commencing July 1, 1944, and ending June 30, 1945, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Four Million, Three Hundred Thirty-five Thousand, Eight Hundred Sixty-one Dollars and Thirty-nine Cents (\$4,335,861.39) or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the expenses of the Territory of Alaska for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1943, and ending March 31, 1944, and for the fiscal year commencing April 1, 1944, and ending March 31, 1945, said sum to be apportioned according to the following schedules:

AN ACT

CHAPTER 41.

[S. B. 33]

To provide for the prevention, suppression, and control of fires, to establish a fire season, to impose civil and criminal liability for violations, and to repeal Acts inconsistent herewith.
