

Sec. 2708. Accounts of officers audited. Every officer, board and institution of the Territory shall submit the office records, files, accounts and transactions of the officer, board or institution to the Governor for inspection and for audit by an expert accountant to be employed by the Governor. Such audit shall be made within thirty days before the expiration of such officer's term of office or at such time as the Governor shall order and also at the end of each calendar year. The person making the audit shall submit his report to the Governor of Alaska on or before the first day of February of the ensuing year, and submit copies of the same to the Treasurer and Auditor and two additional copies to the Governor for submission to the Senate and House of Representatives at the session of the Legislature following the audit or audits. The expenses of the audit shall be paid out of the appropriation for contingent expenses of the treasurer's office.

CHAPTER 45.

AN ACT

[H. B. 85]

To amend Chapter 65 of the Session Laws of Alaska for 1941 relating to the Traffic Laws and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Chapter 65 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1941, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: Amended.

Highway Traffic Act,—conflicts repealed.

“Section 23. Any Acts or parts of Acts in conflict with Chapter 65 of the Session Laws of Alaska for 1941 and otherwise known as the Alaska Highway Traffic Act are hereby repealed.”

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 46.

[H. B. 72]

To provide for the hospitalization of Tubercular Persons and for the establishment and maintenance of beds or wards in the hospitals of the Territory.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Tuberculosis treated within Territory.

Section 1. The Territorial Department of Health is hereby authorized to provide for the treatment of tubercular patients by contracting for their hospitalization within the Territory, provided that if it be deemed advantageous to do so the department may, in lieu thereof, establish and maintain beds or wards in any of the hospitals of the Territory, and for that purpose may enter into such contracts as may be necessary.

Tubercular wards.

Section 2. The Territorial Department of Health shall have completed a comprehensive survey of the various hospital facilities, on or before, July 31, 1943, and as
