

House Joint Resolutions

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1

WHEREAS, It is necessary and desirable, in providing for the proper maintenance of the Pioneers' Home at Sitka, that an examination and inspection of such home be made by this Legislature as soon as practical.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska: That the Committee on Education, Public Health, Morals and Territorial Offices and Institutions of the Senate, and the Committee on Territorial Institutions of the House of Representatives, be and they hereby are authorized and directed to provide for the transportation of a committee from the Senate and a committee from the House of Representatives from Juneau to Sitka and return, said committee to inspect and examine said Pioneers' Home at Sitka and report to this Legislature their findings and recommendations. That for the purpose of defraying the costs of the transportation of said committees, there is hereby appropriated the sum of Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary for such purpose. Said costs of transportation shall be paid by the Treasurer of Alaska upon vouchers approved by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 2

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

That the Governor of Alaska be, and he hereby is, authorized to employ, for such number of hours per day and for such com-

pensation as shall to him seem necessary and reasonable, a janitor and charwoman to clean, care for and keep in proper order the rooms occupied by the Legislature; and that the expenses necessarily incurred therefor, not in any event to exceed Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars, shall be paid by warrants drawn on the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon vouchers approved by the Governor.

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 3

WHEREAS, it is a well known and generally recognized fact that the cost of living in Alaska is higher by 25%, and more in some sections, than in the Continental United States; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Anthony J. Dimond, Delegate to Congress from Alaska, has introduced at the First Session of the 78th Congress H. R. 347, which provides that every employee of the Post Office Department in Alaska receive a salary of 25% greater than that which is paid employees of said Department occupying similar positions and performing similar duties in the several States and the District of Columbia:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the House of the Sixteenth Session of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska, the Senate concurring, that we heartily endorse the provisions of said H. R. 347 and respectfully request its enactment into law; and

FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Postmaster General of the United States and the Delegate from Alaska.
