### SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

That the Committee on Finance and Corporations in the Senate and the Committee on Ways and Means in the House, at and during the present Session, be authorized to expend the sum of Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars each, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for required supplies and for the employment of additional clerical help.

That the Committees on Judiciary and Federal Relations in the Senate and in the House, at and during the present Session, be authorized to expend the sum of Six Hundred (\$600.00) Dollars each, or as much thereof as may be necessary, for required supplies and for the employment of additional clerical help.

### SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 3

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

RESOLVED: That there be and there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$2,500.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to defray the expenses incurred by the Investigation Committee appointed pursuant to Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 1; such sum shall be expended under the direction of the chairman of the said Committee and shall be paid by the Treasurer upon warrants

or vouchers approved by the Auditor. Each warrant or voucher shall set forth in detail the purpose for which it is drawn.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
