CHAPTER 1

AN ACT

[S. B. 11]

Relating to the qualifications of voters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That citizens of the United States who are otherwise qualified to vote in the Territory of Alaska shall have the right to vote upon reaching the age of eighteen years. ^{Age qualifications.}

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon validation by Congress. ^{Effective date.}

Approved February 6, 1945.
