granted shall be in such amount as will provide the applicant with a reasonable subsistence compatible with decency and health, but shall in no case exceed the rate of Sixty Dollars (\$60.00) per calendar month, provided, that if any person given an allowance under the provisions hereof shall apply for admittance to and shall be admitted to the Alaska Pioneers' Home or any public institution, any allowance granted hereunder shall be suspended during the time such person shall be an inmate of the Home or any other public institution, and any inmate of the Home or other public institution, who is eligible to receive an allowance under the provisions hereof may at any time make application for such allowance in lieu of the support and maintenance provided for him or her in such Home or other public institution."

CHAPTER 11

AN ACT

[H. B. 33]

To amend Section 942, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relative to foreign corporations, and to provide for service of process upon such corporations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 942, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be amended so that the third paragraph thereof reads as follows:

"In case such corporation or company shall have failed to comply with the above provisions

for the appointment of an agent in each division of the Territory upon whom process may be served as hereinabove provided, or shall fail to comply with the provisions of the following section such process may be served upon the clerk of the court of the judicial division in which a cause of action, civil or criminal, may arise against such corporation or company, and such service shall be taken and held in all courts to be valid and binding."

CHAPTER 12

AN ACT

[H. B. 34]

To amend Section 4499, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, by providing for the adjudication of heirs in estates worth less than one thousand dollars.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 4499, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraphs:

"Every administrator shall include in the final account the names and addresses, as far as known to him, of the heirs of the deceased, and the notice of hearing of objections to such account shall further contain a notification to all that the court at such hearing will adjudicate and decree who are the heirs and distributees of the deceased person."
