Title. Section 23. This Act may be referred to as the "Alaska Housing Authority Law."

Emergency. Section 24. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 16

AN ACT

[S. B. 29]

Conveying certain lots and premises in the Townsite of Nome to the United States and declaring an emergency.

Transfer from Territory to agency Federal Government certain real property.

It appearing that the Territory of Alaska is the record owner of a number of lots situate in the Townsite of Nome and more definitely described in Section One of this Act, and it further appearing that said lots have no commercial value and are of no benefit to the Territory of Alaska but are of benefit to the Alaska Communication System, an agency of the Federal Government, which desires to secure possession thereof for use in carrying on its public functions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The Territory of Alaska in consideration of the sum of One Dollar lawful money of the United States to it in hand paid by the United States of America, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby sell and quitclaim unto the United States of America all its right, title, interest and estate in and to all and singular

the following described lots and parcels of land, situate in the Town of Nome, Alaska, according to the official survey of said Town, more definitely described as follows, to-wit: Lots Eighteen (18) and Nineteen (19) in Block sixty-seven (67), located between 4th and 5th Avenues, between "D" and "F" Streets; and Lots Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7) and Eight (8) in Block Sixty-Seven (67), located on Fifth Avenue between "D" and "E" Streets.

Section 2. The Governor of Alaska is hereby authorized and directed to execute a quitclaim deed, in the name and on behalf of this Territory, conveying to the United States of America all of the Territory's right, title, interest and estate in and to said Lots and each of them.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 17

AN ACT

[H. B. 9]

To provide for payment of retirement salaries to teachers; to provide for the establishment of a fund for that purpose; to provide for its administration by a board of control and to create a system of contribution to the said fund, and making an appropriation therefor.
