Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of \$280.00 is hereby appropriated out of the moneys in the Treasury of the Territory not otherwise appropriated to reimburse Ralph A. Treffers for his expenses in providing transportation for students on the Eagle River Route to and from the Tee Harbor Territorial School, near Juneau, Alaska, from January 17, 1944, to May 19, 1944, inclusive.

CHAPTER 19

AN ACT

[H. B. 38]

To amend Section 5053, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, by providing for consecutive sentences in the case of convictions for two or more crimes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

SECTION 1. Section 5053, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following provision:

“If the defendant is convicted of two or more

crimes, before judgment on either, the judgment may be that the imprisonment upon any one conviction commence at the expiration of the imprisonment of any other of such crimes. And if the defendant be in imprisonment upon a previous judgment on a conviction for a crime, the judgment may be that the imprisonment may commence at the expiration of the term limited by such previous judgments.”

CHAPTER 20

AN ACT

To amend sub-section (a) (3) of Section 10 of Chapter 4 of the Extraordinary Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, as amended by Chapters 1 and 51, Session Laws of Alaska, 1939, as amended by Chapter 40, Session Laws of Alaska, 1941, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That sub-division (a) (3) of Section 10 of Chapter 4 of the Extraordinary Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, as amended by Chapters 1 and 51, Session Laws of Alaska, 1939, as amended by Chapter 40, Session Laws of Alaska, 1941, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:
