

## CHAPTER 35

## AN ACT

[H. B. 99]

To reimburse St. Ann's Hospital of Juneau, Alaska, in the amount of \$1,105.50, for hospitalization and services rendered certain indigents.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Appropriation  
to St. Ann's  
Hospital for  
services to  
indigents.

Section 1. The sum of One Thousand One Hundred Five Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$1,105.50) is hereby appropriated out of the funds in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated to reimburse St. Ann's Hospital of Juneau, Alaska, for hospitalization and services rendered the following indigents:

Section 2. Payments of the total of the above amount, or so much as will be approved by the Director of Public Welfare, shall be made upon vouchers approved by the Director of Public Welfare.

## CHAPTER 36

## AN ACT

[H. B. 73]

To authorize cities of the second class to grant franchises for the

construction, operation and maintenance of electric light and power plants, water works, heat, power, light and telephone distribution systems and to regulate the rates charged for public utility service; and to declare an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. All laws relating to the powers, duties, authority and jurisdiction of cities of the first class to grant franchises for the construction, operation and maintenance of electric light and power plants, water works, light, heat, power and telephone distribution systems and for other public service and to regulate the rates charged or to be charged by persons, firms or corporations furnishing any public service to cities of the first class and the inhabitants thereof are hereby extended to and made applicable to cities of the second class and the inhabitants thereof. Authorizing cities of second class to grant franchises.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval. Emergency.

## CHAPTER 37

### AN ACT

[H. B. 64]

To appropriate the sum of \$13,292.02 deficiency appropriation, to be used in paying for tuition for school children for the years ending June 30, 1943, 1944 and 1945.

*Be it enacted in the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the sum of \$13,292.02 not otherwise appropriated, or so much as may be necessary, be appro- Deficiency appropriation for tuition.
