Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. All laws relating to the powers, duties, authority and jurisdiction of cities of the first class to grant franchises for the construction, operation and maintenance of electric light and power plants, water works, light, heat, power and telephone distribution systems and for other public service and to regulate the rates charged or to be charged by persons, firms or corporations furnishing any public service to cities of the first class and the inhabitants thereof are hereby extended to and made applicable to cities of the second class and the inhabitants thereof. Authorizing cities of second class to grant franchises.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval. Emergency.

Section 1. That the sum of \$13,292.02 not otherwise appropriated, or so much as may be necessary, be appro- Deficiency appropriation for tuition.

priated to meet a deficiency in the appropriation for tuition of school children for the years ending June 30, 1943, 1944 and 1945.

CHAPTER 38

AN ACT

[H. B. 60]

To authorize the Treasurer to waive provisions of Chapter 41, Session Laws of Alaska, 1939, providing for payment of bounties on Wolves and Coyotes; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Authority to pay
certain claims.
wolf bounty.

Section 1. The Territorial Treasurer is hereby authorized to approve vouchers and pay claims for bounties on wolves and coyotes made upon applications which failed to comply with the provisions of Chapter 41, Session Laws of Alaska, 1939, if in his opinion any such claim is made in good faith and without design to defraud the Territory. But the authority herein granted shall not extend beyond March 31, 1945.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
