## CHAPTER 38

### AN ACT

[H. B. 60]

To authorize the Treasurer to waive provisions of Chapter 41, Session Laws of Alaska, 1939, providing for payment of bounties on Wolves and Coyotes; and to declare an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Authority to pay  
certain claims.  
wolf bounty.

Section 1. The Territorial Treasurer is hereby authorized to approve vouchers and pay claims for bounties on wolves and coyotes made upon applications which failed to comply with the provisions of Chapter 41, Session Laws of Alaska, 1939, if in his opinion any such claim is made in good faith and without design to defraud the Territory. But the authority herein granted shall not extend beyond March 31, 1945.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 39

### AN ACT

[H. B. 24]

To appropriate the sum of Four Thousand Dollars deficiency appro-

priation, to be used in paying for transportation of school children for the biennium ending June 30, 1945, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the sum of Four Thousand Dollars, not otherwise appropriated, or so much as may be necessary, be appropriated to meet a deficiency in the appropriation for transportation of school children for the biennium ending June 30, 1945.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall become effective upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 40

### AN ACT

[S. B. 36]

Designating certain duties and responsibilities for the conduct of audits to the Board of Administration of the Territory of Alaska, and to repeal Chapter 15, Session Laws of Alaska, 1937, and Section 2708, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, as amended by Chapter 44, Session Laws of Alaska, 1943, and making an appropriation therefor.

Section 1. The Board of Administration of the Territory of Alaska as provided for by law shall cause to be audited by competent public accountants at least once each biennium the financial records of every officer, board, institution and individual engaged in handling funds of the Territory of Alaska, and shall submit a report of such audits to the Governor of Alaska who shall submit the
