

Session Laws of Alaska, 1935, and adding Section 1960 thereto.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Sections 1931, 1932, 1933, 1934, 1935 and 1936 of CHAPTER XXXVI of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, as amended by Chapter 11 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1935, be amended by striking the word "Secretary" wherever it occurs in each of the said sections and substituting therefor the word "Auditor".

Auditor authorized call bids legislative printing.

Section 2. That the said Chapter XXXVI of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be amended by adding Section 1960 which shall read as follows:

Section 1960. That thirty days prior to the opening of any legislative session for the Territory of Alaska it shall be the duty of the Auditor to call for bids and enter into contracts for the printing required by this chapter and also for the purchase of all supplies required by the said Legislature.

Time calling bids.

CHAPTER 4

AN ACT

[H. B. 13]

To reimburse the Tye-Phillips Funeral Home of Fairbanks, Alaska, for services rendered in connection with the burial of Petro Yabovancian and making an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

The sum of Ninety Dollars (\$90.00) is hereby appropriated out of the moneys in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated to reimburse the Tye-Phillips

Reimbursing Tye-Phillips Funeral Home.

Funeral Home of Fairbanks, Alaska for the funeral services in connection with the burial of Petro Yabovancian. The payment of said amount herein appropriated shall be made upon a voucher approved by the Auditor of the Territory of Alaska.

CHAPTER 5

AN ACT

[H. B. 18]

To amend Chapter CXIII of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, entitled Actions to declare void or dissolve the marriage contract, by adding Section 3998 thereto, requiring Clerks of the Court to report Decrees issued and to provide compensation for services rendered.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Chapter CXIII of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be amended by adding Section 3998 thereto, to read as follows:

Annulment or
divorce reported
to Registrar
Vital Statistics.

“Sec. 3998. Reports of Divorces and Annulments; compensation for reports filed. The Clerk of Court issuing any decree of annulment or divorce shall, within ten days after the end of the month in which said decree is issued, send a report of the same to the Registrar of Vital Statistics of the Territory of Alaska, which said report shall contain the title of the Court issuing the decree, the place where said decree was issued, the date thereof, and the names of the parties in the decree.

Fees provided.

For each report received by the Registrar of Vital Statistics, he shall compensate the said Clerk of the Court in the same manner and the same amount as is paid for other vital statistic records received from United
