

Treasurer to invest in U. S. Bonds with approval of Board of Administration.

Section 1. Whenever there is in excess of One Million Dollars in unappropriated funds in the Territorial Treasury, the Treasurer, by and with the consent and approval of the Board of Administration, is authorized and empowered to invest in interest bearing bonds of the United States of America and sell such bonds that are in his possession or may come into his possession in such amounts as said Board shall approve.

CHAPTER 52

AN ACT

[S. B. 32]

To authorize the Governor to negotiate with the Surgeon General of the United States Army for the sale and transfer of the Fort Raymond Hospital, located at Seward, Alaska, to the Territory of Alaska, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Governor authorized to negotiate for purchase of buildings from Army at Seward.

Section 1. That the Governor of the Territory is hereby authorized to enter into negotiations with the Surgeon General of the United States Army for the sale and transfer to the Territory of Alaska of all of the buildings, wards, barracks, storehouses, boiler houses, infirmaries, and all other buildings, equipment and facilities known as the Fort Raymond Hospital located at Fort Raymond, Seward, Alaska.

Appropriation.

Section 2. The sum of \$14,500.00 is hereby appropriated for such purchase, out of the funds in the Treasury of the Territory not otherwise appropriated; provided, however, that the purchase shall not be consummated and said funds not used until such time as some municipality, Federal Agency, association, person or persons shall, in some manner, guarantee or otherwise satisfy

Proviso.

the Governor and the Territorial Board of Administration that said property, when acquired, shall not in any way become a financial burden to the Territory. It is further provided, that the Governor, by and with the consent of the Board of Administration, may transfer title to said property for not less than the purchase price to any person or agency who, in the Board's opinion, will use the said property in a manner benefitting the Territory in some degree. May transfer.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act will take effect immediately upon its passage and approval. Emergency.

CHAPTER 53

AN ACT

[S. B. 62]

Authorizing the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners to acquire title in the name of the Territory, to a certain parcel of land near the Town of Haines, Alaska, appropriating the funds therefor and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the monies allotted to the First Judicial Division for the construction of roads and trails, for the immediate acquisition by purchases or condemnation, of a certain parcel of land in the vicinity of the Town of Haines, Alaska more particularly described as follows, to wit: "Beginning at corner No. 1 of U. S. Survey No. 207, thence North eighty degrees, fifty-three minutes West, ten and fourteen hundredths (10.14) chains to corner No. 2; thence North seven (7) chains to Purchase property at Haines.
