CHAPTER 6

AN ACT

[S. B. 15]

To amend Section 1 of Chapter 6 Session Laws of Alaska, 1943, subsection (14) thereof, and by adding a new sub-section after subsection (18) to be known as subsection (19) relating to the control, manufacture, possession, sale, prescription, administering, dispensing and compounding of “Narcotic drugs”, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Subsection (14) of Section 1, Chapter 6 Session Laws of Alaska, 1943, is hereby amended to read as follows:

“(14) ‘Narcotic Drugs’ mean cocoa leaves, opium, cannabis, isonipecaine and every substance neither chemically nor physically distinguishable from them.”

Definitions
Narcotic Drugs.

Section 2. That Section 1, Chapter 6 Session Laws of Alaska, 1943, be amended by adding after subsection (18) thereof, a new subsection to be known as subsection (19), reading as follows:

“(19) Isonipecaine means the substance identified chemically as 1-methyl-4-phenyl-piperidine-4-carboxylic acid ethyl ester, or any salt thereof by whatever trade name identified.”

Isonipecaine
defined.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared and this ^{Emergency.}

Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 7

AN ACT

[S. B. 26]

To provide for the payment of salaries to certain Members of the Territorial Legislature, Seventeenth Session, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Salaries of
Legislators

Section 1. That the sum of One Hundred and Sixty-five (\$165.00) Dollars, is hereby appropriated for the payment of salaries, in the amounts herein specified, to the following Members of the Seventeenth Session of the Territorial Legislature: Senator Don Carlos Brownell, \$105.00; Representative Clayton A. Pollard, \$30.00; Representative Walter E. Huntley, \$30.00.

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
