HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 1

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, copies of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, were furnished to each member of the Seventeenth Session of the Alaska Legislature for the use of the members in consideration of legislation before them; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the said members to take the said Compiled Laws to their respective homes at the end of the session;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That each member of the Seventeenth Session of the Alaska Legislature be permitted to take the volume used by him during the present session, with him.
