## CHAPTER 11

### AN ACT

[S. B. 21]

To provide for the making of a survey of all hospitals and health center facilities in the Territory of Alaska; and making an appropriation.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. Hospital Survey. The Department of Health of the Territory of Alaska is hereby empowered to:

(a) Make a survey of the location, size, and character of all existing public and private (proprietary as well as non-profit) hospitals and health centers in the Territory of Alaska; Survey of hospitals.

(b) Evaluate the sufficiency of such hospitals and health centers to supply the necessary physical facilities for furnishing adequate hospital, clinic and similar services to all of the people of the Territory of Alaska; and,

Compile data

(c) Compile such data and conclusion, together with a statement of the additional facilities necessary, in conjunction with existing structures, to supply such services, and prepare a Territorial Plan for all future hospital constructions.

Section 2. The Department of Health of the Territory of Alaska shall utilize, so far as practicable, any appropriate reports, surveys, and plans prepared by other Territorial agencies.

Section 3. Advisory Council. The Governor shall designate a Territorial Advisory Council to consult with the Territorial Department of Health in carrying out the purposes of Section 1. The Advisory Council shall include a representative of the Alaska Development Board, the Alaska Native Service, the Veterans' Administration, the Federal Works Agency, the United States Public Health Service, the Department of Health, and an Alaskan resident from each Judicial Division, constituting the Board of Health.

Section 4. The Department of Health, acting on the advice of the Advisory Council, is hereby authorized and empowered to approve the construction of hospitals and health center facilities, and the expansion of existing hospital facilities.

Section 5. Acceptance of Grants. The Department of Health of the Territory of Alaska is authorized to accept on behalf of the Territory and to deposit with the Territorial Treasurer any grant from the Federal Government, or gift or contribution from any source made to assist in meeting the cost of carrying out the purposes of Section 1 hereof, and to expend the same for such purposes.

Section 6. The sum of \$5,000.00 is hereby appropri-

ated out of the funds in the Treasury of the Territory, not otherwise appropriated, to carry out the purposes of this Act. Appropriation.

CHAPTER 12

AN ACT

[H. B. 45]

To amend Sections 1331 and 1332, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to Territorial refunds to school districts; to increase such refunds and include Independent School Districts; and establishing an effective date.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. Sections 1331 and 1332, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, are hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1331. Refund for maintenance; definition. Such per centum of the total amount expended for the maintenance of public elementary schools and high schools, within the limits of any incorporated city or incorporated school district or independent School District as the Legislature may from time to time direct, shall be refunded to the school fund of said incorporated city or incorporated school district or Independent School District from the moneys of the Territory as hereinafter set forth: Provided, that no expense incurred for the construction of buildings or for the repair, alteration or improvement of buildings or for the purchase of building sites or for interest on
