

## CHAPTER 2

## AN ACT

[H. B. 4]

To secure an expression of the opinion of the voters of the territory on the form of primary ballot.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Primary ballot.

Section 1. That there shall be submitted to the voters of the Territory of Alaska, at the next general election the question of choice of form of primary ballot.

Section 2. There shall be given to each voter at said general election a separate ballot in substantially the following form:

Formal ballot.

“I favor changing to the blanket primary ballot system in which all names appear on one ballot in the primary election. (Yes .....)  
(No .....).”

Section 3. The returns of the election shall be canvassed in the manner prescribed for general elections and the result shall be certified and transmitted by the Secretary of the Territory to the Legislature at the next regular session in January, 1947, in order that it may take such action as may be necessary in conformance with the result of the referendum.

## CHAPTER 3

## AN ACT

[H. B. 5]

To extend Section 8 of the Selective Training and Service Act of

1940, as amended, to the Territory of Alaska and political subdivisions thereof, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. Section 8 of the Selective Training Service Act of 1940, as amended, is hereby extended to the Territory of Alaska and its political subdivisions, it being the intent of this Act that all reemployment benefits granted by Section 8 of the Selective Training and Service Act of 1940 to any veteran who was in the employ of a private employer at the time of his induction into the armed forces of the United States shall, in the same manner and to the same extent, be granted to any veteran who was in the employ of the Territory of Alaska or any political subdivision thereof at the time of his induction into the armed forces of the United States.

Selective Service re-employment extended to Territorial employees.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

Emergency clause.

## CHAPTER 4

### AN ACT

[H. B. 20]

To amend Sec. 6 of Ch. 26, Session Laws of Alaska, 1945, pertaining to the Health Department, by adding a penalty clause, defining offenses and prescribing penalties.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Sec. 6 of Ch. 26, Session Laws of Alaska, 1945, is hereby amended to make the sub-title
