

the financial requirements of the Land Registration Program for the ensuing biennium, including such estimated expenditures of the register of each district land office performing services under this Act.

Section 2. That there is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$20,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the expenses of the Land Registration Program for the period ending March 31st, 1947, said sum to be apportioned by the Territorial Treasurer as required to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, ^{Emergency} and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its _{clause.} passage and approval.

CHAPTER 7

AN ACT

[H. B. 46]

To amend Chapter 77, Session Laws of Alaska 1935, relating to Independent School Districts; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Chapter 77 Session Laws of Alaska 1935, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. The people of any incorporated city and its adjacent settlement, or settlements

may incorporate as Independent School Districts in the manner hereinafter provided, but such districts shall not embrace more than two hundred fifty (250) square miles of territory.

Section 2. That Section 14 of Chapter 77 Session Laws of Alaska 1935, is hereby amended by adding thereto at the end thereof, as follows:

Further provided: That all provisions in Sections 1331 to 1336 inclusive, Compiled Laws of Alaska 1933, requiring refunds of Territorial money to cities and incorporated school districts, and establishing procedures therefor, are hereby made applicable to Independent School Districts.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 8

AN ACT

To provide minimum salaries for School Teachers and salary ranges within which refunds to School Districts will be made; and establishing an effective date.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:
