

House Joint Resolutions

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA IN THE EXTRAORDINARY SESSION ASSEMBLED:

1. That the sum of \$8,200.00, or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the payment of salaries to persons employed by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska during the present session, said sum to be apportioned according to the following schedules:

- (A) For the salaries of the chief clerk of the House of Representatives and Secretary of the Senate, \$8.00 per day, assistant secretary of the Senate, assistant clerk of the House of Representatives, enrolling clerks, engrossing clerks, sergeants-at-arms, doorkeepers, messengers, and watchmen, at \$5.00 Per Day, the sum of \$2,580.00
- (B) As additional compensation for services rendered by the chief clerk of the House of Representatives and Secretary of the Senate, \$4.00 per day; for the assistant clerk of the House of Representatives, and assistant secretary of the Senate, \$6.00 per day, for the enrolling clerks, engrossing clerks, sergeants-at-arms, doorkeepers, messengers, and watchmen, in excess of regular working hours and for work done on week-ends and holidays, \$4.00 per day, the sum of \$3,100.00
- (C) For salaries of the clerks to the Judiciary Committees of the Senate and the House of Representatives \$11.00 per day each, and three additional clerks for the House of Rep-

representatives and Senate at \$9.00 per day each; and for salaries of the chaplains of the Senate and House of Representatives, at \$4.00 per day each, the sum of \$2,520.00

2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the sum of \$18,000.00 or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the payment of the salaries of the members of the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska during the extraordinary session, at the rate of \$15.00 per day and that said sum be appropriated for such purpose.

3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the sum of \$12,000.00 or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the payment of mileage, incoming and outgoing, for each member of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska during the present extraordinary session, at the rate of fifteen cents (15c) per mile, incoming and outgoing.

4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives are authorized to employ for such number of hours per day and for such compensation as to them shall seem necessary and reasonable, a janitor and charwoman, to clean, care for and keep in proper orders the rooms occupied by the Legislature, and for the purpose of paying the wages of such janitor and charwoman there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$375.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary.

5. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives are hereby authorized and directed to secure necessary telephone service for use of the Legislature, at and during the present session thereof and there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$25.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the payment of such telephone service.

6. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the sum of \$24,000.00 or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the payment of printing and binding of

the Senate and House Journals, Session Laws and advance sheets; and for printing and furnishing stationery and other printing for the use of the Legislature.

7. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the sum of \$1,500.00 or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, for the purchase of mimeograph paper, typewriting paper, stencils, carbons and such other material and supplies as may be necessary for the use of the Legislature.

8. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives are hereby authorized and directed to purchase such necessary supplies as they shall deem necessary for the use of the present Legislature, and the sum of \$750.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated for the payment thereof.

The monies hereby appropriated shall be paid by warrants drawn on the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon vouchers approved by the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives; and

9. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 2
