HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 3

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY
 OF ALASKA IN EXTRAORDINARY SESSION ASSEMBLED:

1. That the sum of \$1250.00 is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the payment of the work involved in the compiling of the Journals of the Senate and the House of Representatives subsequent to the present session, said sum to be apportioned according to the following schedules:

- A. For compensation of Jesta M. Young, for work performed at the request of the Legislature subsequent to the present session\$150.00
- B. For compensation to Thomas B. Stewart, for work performed at the request of the Legislature subsequent to the present session\$150.00
- C. For compensation to Edward D. Coffey, for supervising and preparing the Senate Journal subsequent to the present session of the Legislature, 5 days at \$15.00 per day\$ 75.00
- D. For compensation to Jesse D. Lander, for supervising and preparing the House Journal subsequent to the present session of the Legislature, 5 days at \$15.00 per day\$ 75.00

- E. For compensation of employees of the Legislature, other than the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House; to be allotted under the direction of the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House\$800.00

2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the sum of \$12,000.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the payment of per diem in lieu of subsistence at the rate of \$7.00 per day for the members of the Legislature.

3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
