HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 1

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, the Honorable Joseph B. Diamond, a member of the House of Representatives of the Seventeenth Territorial Legislature, departed this life on October 1, 1945; and,

WHEREAS, it is entirely fitting and proper that the members of the House of Representatives of the Seventeenth Legislature in the Territory of Alaska commemorate his excellent service as a member of this body during the regular session held in 1945; and,

WHEREAS, because his devotion to duty, his unflinching loyalty and his subtle sense of humor contributed in a large measure to the accomplishments of this body at its regular session in 1945; and,

WHEREAS, his passing has left a void in the hearts of his fellow members;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the House of Representatives of the Seventeenth Territorial Legislature in Extraordinary Session assembled that the untimely passing of the Honorable Joseph B. Diamond is deeply regretted by the members of this body and that in his passing the Territory has lost a conscientious Legislator; and the Third Division of Alaska has lost an able Representative; and that the heartfelt sympathy of the members of this body be expressed to the members of his family; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution be spread upon and made of record in the Journal of this House of Representatives of the Seventeenth Legislature in Extraordinary Session assembled, and that a copy hereof be sent to the members of the family of Honorable Joseph B. Diamond.
