

LAWS OF ALASKA

Extraordinary Session

CHAPTER 1

AN ACT

[H. B. 6]

To approve, adopt and make of force as the Code of Alaska, the new compilation of laws authorized by the Legislature in Ch. 28 Session Laws of Alaska, 1947; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The compilation of laws obtained by the Alaska Law Compilation Commission under authority of Ch. 28 Session Laws of Alaska, 1947, as edited and published by Bancroft-Whitney Company, law book publishers of San Francisco, California, and identified as Alaska Compiled Laws Annotated, 1949, embodying Volumes 1, 2 and 3, but with consecutive section numbers throughout, is hereby adopted and made of force as the Code of Alaska. All existing statutory provisions contained in said compilation which emanate from the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1913, and Alaska Session Laws from 1913 to 1947 inclusive, and special Acts of Congress for Alaska, all as heretofore amended, are hereby re-enacted as they presently appear in said compilation. All acts or parts of acts heretofore enacted by the Alaska Legislature which have not been incorporated in said compilation because of previously enacted general repeal clauses or by virtue of repeals by implication or otherwise are hereby expressly repealed.

Section 2. Said volumes may be generally referred as "The Alaska Code" but by way of a short form in citing specific sections, the abbreviation "(Sec. No.) ACLA 1949" shall be used.

Emergency

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 2

AN ACT

[H. B. 7]

To authorize the purchase of five typewriters for use in the Legislature; and making provision for payment of balance due on mimeographs; making an appropriation; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Typewriter
purchase.

Section 1. That the committee on printing in the House of Representatives is hereby authorized to negotiate for the purchase of five typewriters for the use of the Legislature.

Appropriations.

Section 2. That the sum of \$750.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of funds in the general treasury not otherwise appropriated for the purpose of carrying the provisions of this Act into effect.

Section 3. That the sum of \$350.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated
