CHAPTER 114

AN ACT

[H. B. 121]

To appropriate the sum of \$13,041,656.80 or as much thereof as shall be found necessary for the expenses of the Territory of Alaska for the Biennium beginning April 1, 1949 and ending March 31, 1951, and for the school biennium beginning July 1, 1949 and ending June 30, 1951, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of \$13,041,656.80 or so much thereof as shall be found necessary is hereby appropriated

out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the expenses of the Territory for the biennium commencing April 1, 1949 and ending March 31, 1951, and for the school biennium commencing July 1, 1949 and ending June 30, 1951, said sum to be apportioned according to the following schedules:

CHAPTER 115

AN ACT

[H. B. 92]

Pertaining to Taxation; levying a general Net Income Tax in Alaska; providing for collection thereof; defining offenses and prescribing penalties; repealing, subject to a savings clause, House Bill No. 1 of the Extraordinary Session of the Nineteenth Legislature, which will become Chapter 3 of the Session Laws of said session; and further repealing the taxes referred to in Section 16 of this Act; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. SHORT TITLE. This Act may be cited as the "Alaska Net Income Tax Act".
