

CHAPTER 122

AN ACT

[Senate Finance Committee Substitute for S. B. 13]
Pertaining to salaries of Territorial officials and employees; re-
pealing Sec. 11-3-5 ACLA 1949; and fixing an effective date.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. ADMINISTRATIVE SALARY SCHEDULE.

(a) The annual salaries of Territorial officials as hereinafter specified are hereby set and established as compensation in full for performance of the duties usually incident to their respective offices and for such other Territorial duties as are or may be assigned to them unless specifically allowed by the Legislature: Salary schedule.

(1) Attorney General, including duties as legal member of the Alaska Industrial Board, \$9,000.00.

(2) Auditor, including duties as Insurance Commissioner, \$7,500.00.

(3) Treasurer, including duties as Administrator of the Land Registration Program, \$7,500.00.

(4) Highway Engineer, including duties for Territorial Board of Road Commissioners, \$8,000.00.

(5) Commissioner of Labor, including duties as Chairman of the Alaska Industrial Board, \$7,500.00.

(6) Commissioner of Agriculture, including administration of the Veterinarian's Program, \$7,500.00

(7) Commissioner of Mines, including supervision of assay offices, \$8,000.00.

(8) Commissioner of Taxation, \$8,000.00.

(9) Director of Public Welfare, \$7,500.00.

(10) Director of Unemployment Compensation Commission, \$8,000.00.

(11) Territorial Commissioner of Veterans' Affairs, \$8,000.00.

(12) Commissioner of Education, \$8,000.00.

(13) Manager, Development Board, \$7,500.00.

(b) The Commissioner of Health shall have such salary, commensurate with his professional or specialized abilities, as the Board of Health sees fit to allow, not exceeding \$12,000.00 per annum.

(c) (1) Curator of Museum, \$7,000.00.

(2) Director, Alaska Aeronautics, \$7,000.00.

(3) Superintendent, Pioneers' Home, \$6,000.00.

(4) Director, Fisheries Products Laboratory, \$7,000.00.

(d) (1) Assistant Attorney General, \$7,000.00.

(2) Deputy Commissioner of Education, \$7,000.00.

(3) Education Supervisors, \$6,000.00.

(4) Deputy Auditor, \$6,500.00.

- (5) Assistant Treasurer, \$6,500.00.
- (6) Deputy Commissioner of Labor, \$6,500.00.
- (7) Territorial Assayers, \$6,500.00.

(e) Territorial employees not above specified shall have a percentage increase based on respective present rates of pay, as follows :

\$400.00 per month or over:	10%
\$375.00 to \$400.00 per month:	11%
\$350.00 to \$375.00 per month:	12%
\$325.00 to \$350.00 per month:	13%
\$300.00 to \$325.00 per month:	14%
Under \$300.00 per month:	15%

(f) The salaries of teachers and other employees paid from lump sum appropriations shall be in accordance with other provisions of law pertaining to them and in accordance with such employment contracts as they have or may have entered into with their respective agencies.

(g) The Territorial Board of Administration is authorized and directed to study and prepare for recommendation to the next legislature a uniform graduated salary schedule for Territorial employees based on a merit system embodying graduated salary features, job classifications and job analysis provisions and providing for reclassification at periodic intervals, merit salary increases, non-pirating of personnel within Territorial Departments and other needed provisions.

Appropriation.

The sum of \$2,500.00 or so much thereof as may be required is hereby authorized for this study to be transferred from Section 2 of the general appropriations Bill passed by the 19th Legislature.

Section 2. REPEAL. Sec. 11-3-5 ACLA 1949 is hereby repealed.

Repeal.

Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act shall become effective upon and including April 1, 1949.

CHAPTER 123

AN ACT

[S. B. 30]

Relating to aeronautics; providing for the development and regulation thereof; creating a Department of Aviation; expanding the powers and duties of the Alaska Aeronautics and Communications Commission; establishing the Alaska Aeronautics Revolving Fund; modifying the Motor Fuel Tax Act; repealing Secs. 32-4-1 to 32-4-4 inc., Secs. 32-5-1 to 32-5-9 inc., Sec. 32-6-1, Sec. 32-6-9 and the last sentence of Sec. 32-3-8 ACLA 1949, making an appropriation; and fixing an effective date.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. DEFINITIONS. As used in this Act, unless the context otherwise requires:

Definitions.

“Aeronautics” means the science and art of flight including but not limited to transportation by aircraft; the operation, construction, repair or maintenance of aircraft power plants and accessories, including the re-
