

Savings clause.

Section 15. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the provisions or application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

Section 16. AMENDMENT: Secs. 32-6-5 to 32-6-8 inc. ACLA 1949 are hereby amended by striking the words "Territorial Treasurer" wherever appearing in said sections and substituting therefor the words "Division of Aeronautics".

Title.

Section 17. SHORT TITLE. This Act may be cited as the Alaska Aeronautics Act.

Repeals.

Section 18. REPEALS. Secs. 32-4-1 to 32-4-4 inc., Secs. 32-5-1 to 32-5-9 inc., and Sec. 32-6-1 and Sec. 32-6-9 and the last sentence of Sec. 32-3-8 ACLA 1949 are hereby repealed.

Section 19. EFFECTIVE DATE. The effective date of this Act shall be June 1, 1949.

## CHAPTER 124

### AN ACT

[S. B. 51]

To appropriate \$20,000.00 for annual Fairs for the biennium ending March 31, 1951.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Territorial Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$20,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary to furnish aid in conducting and maintaining annual agricultural and industrial fairs and exhibits as provided in Secs. 33-2-1 to 33-2-7 inclusive ACLA 1949. Appropriation.

Section 2. Any community or Fair Association so receiving aid as above shall, upon making a profit on any later fair or exhibit, refund the Territory in whole or in part as they are financially able. Refund to Territory.

## CHAPTER 125

### AN ACT

[S. B. 76]

To authorize reimbursement to certain hospitals in Alaska for services rendered to indigents, making an appropriation, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The Department of Public Welfare is hereby authorized upon duly presented vouchers properly approved to reimburse certain hospitals in Alaska for services rendered to indigents, in accordance with the following schedule: Hospital reimbursement.

St. Ann's Hospital, Juneau	\$4276.80
Ketchikan General Hospital, Ketchikan	\$2550.50
