

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Territorial Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$20,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary to furnish aid in conducting and maintaining annual agricultural and industrial fairs and exhibits as provided in Secs. 33-2-1 to 33-2-7 inclusive ACLA 1949. Appropriation.

Section 2. Any community or Fair Association so receiving aid as above shall, upon making a profit on any later fair or exhibit, refund the Territory in whole or in part as they are financially able. Refund to Territory.

CHAPTER 125

AN ACT

[S. B. 76]

To authorize reimbursement to certain hospitals in Alaska for services rendered to indigents, making an appropriation, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The Department of Public Welfare is hereby authorized upon duly presented vouchers properly approved to reimburse certain hospitals in Alaska for services rendered to indigents, in accordance with the following schedule: Hospital reimbursement.

Appropriation. Section 2. There is hereby appropriated the sum of Twenty-two Thousand Six Hundred Ninety-eight Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$22,698.80) out of the monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, to be expended for the above purpose by the Department of Public Welfare.

Emergency clause. Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 126

AN ACT

[S. B. 87]

Pertaining to operation of municipally owned utilities, and provision of a validation clause respecting actions heretofore taken by municipal utility boards; amending Sec. 2 of Act passed by
