AN ACT

Designating persons authorized to act as attorney for another in Justice Court; and amending Sec. 67-1-9 ACLA 1949.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Sec. 1. That Sec. 67-1-9 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 67-1-9. WHO MAY ACT AS ATTORNEY. Any person may, without compensation, act as attorney for another in a Justice's court, except a person or officer serving any process in the action or proceeding other than a subpoena, and except also any attorney who has been disbarred or any attorney under suspension during such period of suspension. Provided, however, that the United States Marshal, or any Deputy Marshal, in the Judicial Division in which such Justice Court is situated, shall in no case act as prosecutor of, nor as attorney for the defendant in any criminal action tried in said Justice's Courts.
