

CHAPTER 18

AN ACT

[H. B. 6]

To provide for bounties for the killing of wolves and coyotes by amending Sec. 33-3-111 ACLA 1949.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Sec. 33-3-111 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 33-3-111. BOUNTY DECLARED:
AMOUNT AND PAYMENT. There is hereby placed upon every wild lobo or timber wolf and every wild coyote or prairie wolf, legally taken within the Territory; bounties of Fifty Dollars on wolves and Thirty Dollars on coyotes, said sums to be paid in accordance with provisions hereof.

CHAPTER 19

AN ACT

[S. B. 19]

Authorizing the Territorial Board of Education to transfer funds available in its biennial appropriations from an item or items containing a surplus to an item or items where there may be a deficiency; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Transfer of funds.

Section 1. The Territorial Board of Education is hereby authorized and empowered, upon the affirmative vote in writing of a majority of all its members, and during the last six months of any biennium for which the moneys hereinafter mentioned have been appropriated, to transfer funds available for the support of schools from an item or items in which a surplus will apparently occur to an item or items pertaining to the support of schools where there may be a deficiency. Likewise transfers may be made from one item to another within appropriations for the office of the Commissioner of Education.

Notification of Auditor.

Section 2. No transfer of funds, as above authorized, will be effective for vouchering purposes unless and until the office of the Auditor has been officially notified thereof in writing.

Emergency clause

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 20

AN ACT

[S. B. 161]

Pertaining to liens for work or labor done or materials furnished; amending Sec. 26-1-1 ACLA 1949; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Sec. 26-1-1 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:
