

LAWS OF ALASKA

Regular Session

CHAPTER 1

AN ACT

[S. B. 6]

To appropriate the sum of (\$7,500.00) Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be expended by the Department of Public Welfare for Relief of Destitution for the biennium ending March 31, 1949; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated the sum of (\$7,500.00) Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary, out of the money in the Treasury of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, to be expended by the Department of Public Welfare for Relief of Destitution during the biennium ending March 31, 1949. Deficiency appropriation.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval. Emergency clause.

Approved February 1, 1949.

CHAPTER 2

AN ACT

[H. B. 14]

To appropriate the sum of \$1500.00 for expenses of the Office of Territorial Treasurer for the biennium ending March 31, 1949; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of \$1500.00, or so much thereof as may be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the expenses of the office of the Territorial Treasurer for the biennium ending March 31, 1949. This appropriation shall be in addition to moneys heretofore appropriated for said office for said biennium and shall be apportioned according to the following schedule:

Extra Clerical Help, January 1 to March 31, 1949	\$900.00
Printing, Postage, Office Supplies and Equipment and Contingent Ex- pense	\$600.00

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

Approved February 7, 1949.

CHAPTER 3

AN ACT

[H. B. 291]

To pay the Massachusetts Bonding and Insurance Company \$5,417.68, excess payment made on their premium tax, as shown on their tax statement for the year 1946.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the Territorial Treasury not otherwise
