

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Transfer of funds.

Section 1. The Territorial Board of Education is hereby authorized and empowered, upon the affirmative vote in writing of a majority of all its members, and during the last six months of any biennium for which the moneys hereinafter mentioned have been appropriated, to transfer funds available for the support of schools from an item or items in which a surplus will apparently occur to an item or items pertaining to the support of schools where there may be a deficiency. Likewise transfers may be made from one item to another within appropriations for the office of the Commissioner of Education.

Notification of Auditor.

Section 2. No transfer of funds, as above authorized, will be effective for vouchering purposes unless and until the office of the Auditor has been officially notified thereof in writing.

Emergency clause

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 20

### AN ACT

[S. B. 161]

Pertaining to liens for work or labor done or materials furnished; amending Sec. 26-1-1 ACLA 1949; and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Sec. 26-1-1 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 26-1-1. CERTAIN PERSONS ENTITLED TO LIEN FOR WORK OR LABOR DONE OR MATERIALS FURNISHED. Any person or firm, contractor, lumber merchant, architect, engineer, designer, mechanic, artisan, machinist, tradesman, plumber, electrician, carpenter, painter, laborer, teamster, drayman, and other persons performing design or supervision services or performing any labor upon or preliminary to the construction of, or furnishing any material for the construction, alteration or repair, either in whole or in part, of any building, wharf, bridge, flume, fence, machinery or aqueduct, or any structure or superstructure, shall have a lien upon the same for the work or labor done or material furnished at the instance of the owner of the building or other improvement, or his agent.

Persons entitled to lien.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.

Emergency clause.

## CHAPTER 21

### AN ACT

[S. B. 7]

To amend Section 20-1-4, Alaska Compiled Laws Annotated 1949, prescribing penalties for discrimination in providing full and equal accommodations, facilities and privileges to all citizens in places of accommodation within the jurisdiction of the Territory of Alaska.
