

day on which such bank, trust company or savings and loan association shall, pursuant to such vote and notice, remain closed, shall, with respect to such bank, trust company, national bank or savings and loan association, be deemed a holiday, and no such bank, trust company, national bank or savings and loan association shall be required to permit access to its safe deposit vaults on such day. Where a contract by its terms requires the payment of money or the performance of a condition on any such day by or at such bank, trust company, national bank or savings and loan association, such payment may be made or condition performed on the next business day succeeding such day when such bank, trust company, national bank or savings and loan association shall so remain closed, with the same force and effect as if made or performed in accordance with the terms of the contract.

CHAPTER 23

AN ACT

[H. B. 50]

To provide for defraying certain expenses of the Delegate from Alaska; and making an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. WHEREAS, the Delegate from Alaska is expected by virtue of his office to meet certain quasi-social obligations in the entertainment of dignitaries of the United States Government; and,

WHEREAS, such functions are the business of the Territory of Alaska; and,

WHEREAS, the Delegate is put to great personal expense as a result of such obligations, therefore;

There is hereby appropriated for the period ending March 31, 1951, out of the funds in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$2,500.00, to be drawn in favor of the Delegate in accordance with written request of the Delegate, upon a voucher or vouchers approved by the Territorial Treasurer, for the purpose of partially defraying the expenses of the Delegate from Alaska incurred in the interest of the people of Alaska.

CHAPTER 24

AN ACT

[H. B. 74]

To appropriate the sum of \$1000.00 for transportation of Ludwig Wolf and attendant to the Old Soldiers' Home at Washington, D. C.; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the monies of the Territorial Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of providing transportation of Ludwig Wolf, an inmate of the Pioneers' Home who suffers seriously from a stroke and is eligible for admittance to the Old Soldiers' Home in Washington, D. C.,
